1. Primary Accomplishments in the year 2017-2018 :

- Began organizing a plan to revise articulation guidelines.
 - Connected with other SLPs, including Celeste Gerlach, to learn about proposed revisions/progress that has already taken place
- Fielded questions from SLPs around the state
 - Main concerns include: Pain Management/Human Trafficking training requirements for state license and legal questions regarding IDEA/IEP compliance

2. Major Challenges:

- Determining direction for articulation guidelines revision project
 - Merging previous partial drafts with current guidelines
 - Identifying and prioritizing areas that are of most concern for public school SLPs
- Promoting the advisory assembly to encourage participation of other SLPs

3. Plans/Directions for 2018-2019:

- Will gather input from public schools SLPs regarding how they currently interact with articulation guidelines and provide opportunities for feedback.
- Plan for much of guidelines project work to take place over Summer of 2018
